LANDING CHARGES NOT INCREASED

Texel Airport has **not** increased landing charges for 2011. The charge for most landings (max 1500 kg and noise category 3 up to 8) is for cross-country flights €14,00 (weekends €17,50) and touch & go's are €4,00 (weekends €7,50).

NEWS FROM TEXEL AIRPORT

Taxi-way Paving - In April the contractor *Schraag* from Texel has laid 2.300 m² of so-called "Grass Stone". This material now forms a paved taxi-way between the new Flying Focus and "Texel Aircraft Maintenance" hangars and the apron. This will prolong access to these companies, particularly during the winter period. At the same time a large section (a 6 metre-wide centreline) of the taxi-way towards runway 22 has been paved with "Grass Stone".

At this time this taxi-way is not in use because the grass still needs to grow. Due to the dry spell we have postponed the seeding of new grass and are waiting for a wetter period.

Maintenance on Runway 13 – At the end of April the contractor De Vries & Van de Wiel has tended to the first 200 metres of Runway 13. Particularly after long periods of rain water was standing in this area for too long, which meant that the crosswind runway 13-31 was not always available. The work consisted of digging deep and raising the surface as well as placing extra drains at about 40cm which should resolve the problem.

Also in this case we now need some rain in order to encourage grass to grow on this section. Until then the 13-31 has been temporarily displaced towards the Northeast and the dimensions are 630 x 30m.
